Fiscal Climate

- The town has requested each department to submit a level services budget in light of current economic climate
- Because of several unknown revenue factors actual percentage figures from the town have not yet been determined
- In addition to the challenging revenue factors the town is experiencing, the schools continue to feel the impact of FY2011 eliminated positions, the continued state circuit breaker reductions, and the loss of special education ARRA grants

Budget Process to Date

- Principals & Directors submitted budget requests
- Review and clarification of budget requests is currently underway
- Two School Committee members and the Superintendent met with the Southborough Advisory Committee on October 25, 2010
- Extensive discussion regarding the school district's fiscal outlook took place with the members of the School Committee's Operating Budget Subcommittee on December 3, 2010

- Continuing level funding or decreasing funding in the majority of administrative, instructional, maintenance, and supply accounts
- Again, postponing all new initiatives with financial impact at this point in time
- Carefully monitoring the current 2011 budget, limiting spending to essential items
- Examining our current preK-8 programs and staffing levels
