SELLING: 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. Every Thursday, March 29 through May 31 and
Noon - 2 p.m. Sundays April 1, 15, 22, 29 May 6 & 20.

(Closed Easter April 8, Mother's Day May 13 & Memorial Day Sunday May 27.)



1/2 PRICE SALE DAYS: Sunday May 20 and Thursdays May 24 & 31st.

BAG RUMMAGE SALE: Noon - 2 p.m. Sunday June 2 (\$5.00/bag).



WHAT TO BRING as CONSIGNMENTS and/or DONATIONS



(Donations to our church are especially appreciated!)

Clothing, hats, scarves, purses, shoes, belts and ties may be brought *provided they are clean, in good repair and are currently stylish. Only items for SPRING and SUMMER wear will be accepted for consignment.* Please pre-check items and do not bring anything that is torn, worn out or dirty (even with small spots) because it will be discarded. We cannot accommodate household items or jewelry and must also limit or refuse articles if our selling space has already filled to capacity. **During Receiving Week please limit consignments to 40 items.**



CONSIGNMENTS

Please **list each item separately** on the enclosed form with the other requested information *in advance of your arrival at the Bargain Box.* For extra pages, photocopy our form or download it from our website and bag each page's items separately. (Do not group items--the "no. of pieces" on the form is used for a multi-piece single outfit.) A fair selling price will be set by our workers, so leave the price column blank. **Consignors receive 50% of the sales price if the item is sold** and payments are sent in June. **All articles are left at the owner's risk.** Consignors may pick up unsold items **ONLY on May 10 or May 17.**

DONATIONS

All items will be gratefully accepted *if they meet the condition standards listed above.* When dropping off clothes, please be sure to register your name with our volunteer. At that time, you will be given a receipt for tax purposes for you to fill out with your fair valuation of the items donated. There is no need to fill out the enclosed form if you are donating. *Please save fall and winter articles for our next season.*



At the end of the scheduled season, unsold items are donated to charities.
