## WHAT DOES "NEED BASED" MEAN?

Different programs have different qualifications for eligibility. Some, like Fuel Assistance, have very strict guidelines that need to be met to qualify. Other programs look at a family or individual's circumstances in addition to income levels.

Any person/family enrolling in a program unique to Southborough Youth and Family Services and who receives SNAP benefits, Medicaid, TANF, Fuel Assistance, Free or Reduced Lunch and/or SSDI/SSI is automatically eligible for programming, However, documentation proving enrollment may be necessary to partake in these programs

Southborough Youth and Family Services understands that financial situations can change quickly. A new job can transform a family from being anxious about how to pay bills to being comfortable again and vice-versa--a job loss can throw a family into a tailspin. Because situations can change swiftly, SYFS holds the right to make decisions about programs unique to our department on a case-by-case basis, So if you worry you will not qualify for a program but need the help, please call us.
