

## **OVERVIEW:**

- Flash Flood Watch Issued through 10 PM this evening across interior MA and portions of northern CT.
- Scattered slow moving thunderstorms will be capable of producing 2-4 inches of rain in just an hour resulting in potential for localized flash flooding.

TIMING	Through 10 PM This Evening. Activity should diminish in intensity by late evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Scattered thunderstorms with torrential rainfall and localized flash flooding.</li> <li>Roadways may become flooded and impassable</li> <li>Dangerous cloud to ground lightning with mainly 40-50 mph wind gusts, but an isolated severe thunderstorm with 60 mph gusts possible.</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>How much Flash Flooding will occur across the region and duration of activity into the evening.</li> <li>If activity holds together it is possible the Flash Flood Watch will need to be extended further east later today.</li> </ul>
Post Event Outlook	<ul> <li>Scattered thunderstorms are expected again on Wednesday, but the intensity and areal coverage is expected to be less than today.</li> </ul>
