WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Flash Flood Watch Issued through 10 PM this evening across interior MA and portions of northern CT.
- Scattered slow moving thunderstorms will be capable of producing 2-4 inches of rain in just an hour resulting in potential for localized flash flooding.

TIMING	Through 10 PM This Evening. Activity should diminish in intensity by late evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Scattered thunderstorms with torrential rainfall and localized flash flooding.Roadways may become flooded and impassableDangerous cloud to ground lightning with mainly 40-50 mph wind gusts, but an isolated severe thunderstorm with 60 mph gusts possible.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">How much Flash Flooding will occur across the region and duration of activity into the evening.If activity holds together it is possible the Flash Flood Watch will need to be extended further east later today.
Post Event Outlook	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Scattered thunderstorms are expected again on Wednesday, but the intensity and areal coverage is expected to be less than today.
