SUBJECT: Tree Hearing Appeal – Downtown and Various Streets Project**

As you know, on November 1, 2021, the Tree Warden and the DPW held tree hearings for trees slated for removal due to the St. Mark's Street and Route 85 intersection reconfiguration and improvements project.

Prior to the end of the hearings the DPW received written objections to the removal of all of the trees. The DPW has sent a public hearing advertisement to the Metrowest Daily News advertising the appeal hearing with the Selectmen. The ad will run on November 4th and 8th. That hearing will be remote on November 16th at 7:30. I have attached the information used for the original tree hearing, notes from that hearing, and the project plan referenced at the hearing.

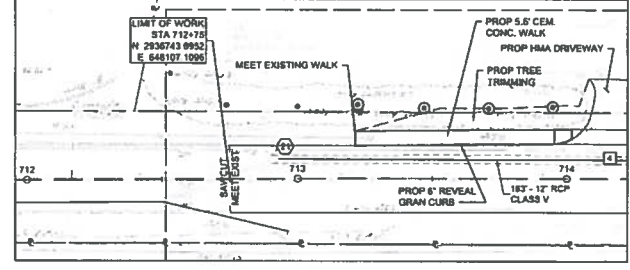
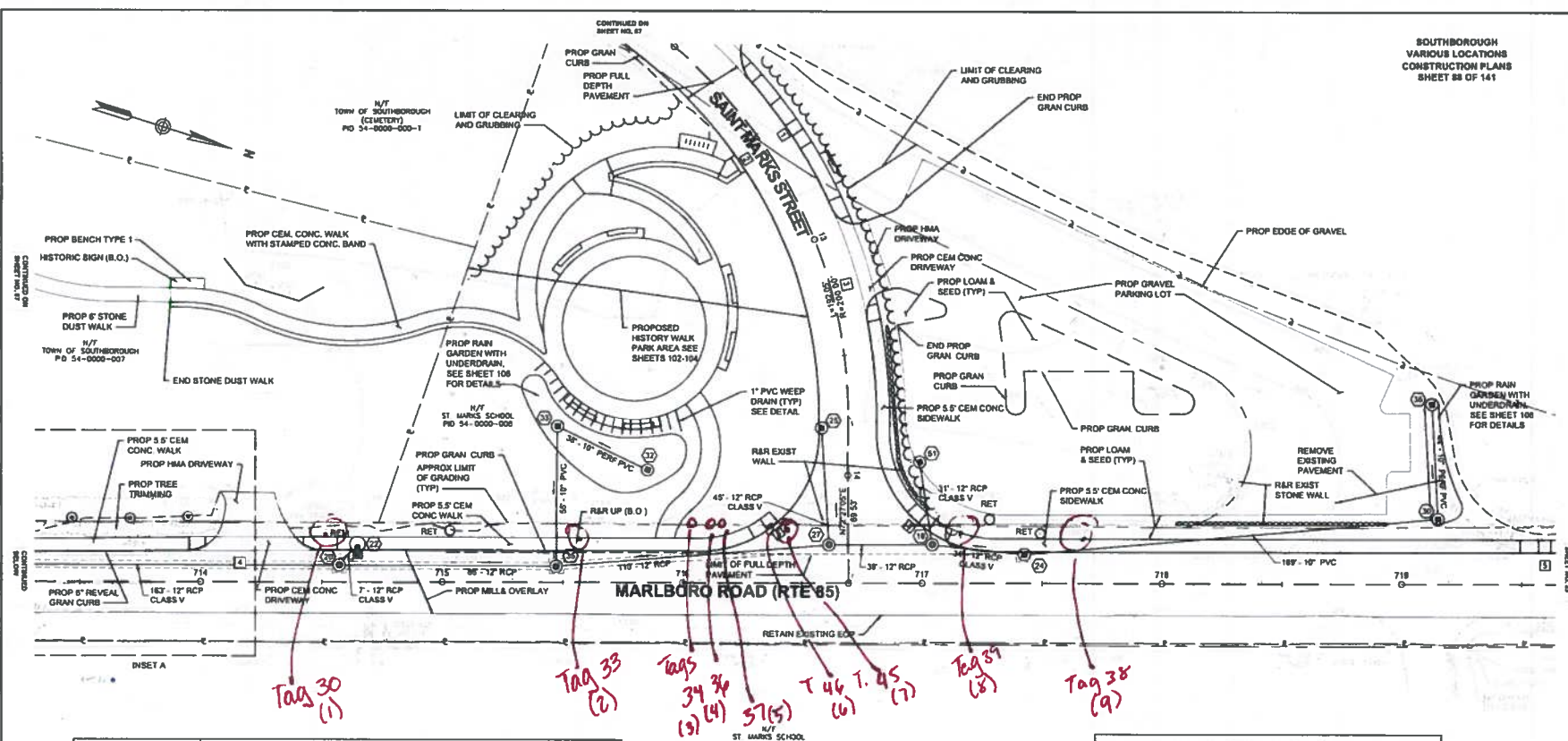
I have also attached other relevant pages regarding the approved work for the intersection improvement, including the new intersection layout, sidewalks on St. Mark's Street, the approved sidewalks on Marlborough Road, drainage, the park layout and the park planting plan. The Town's accepted Complete Streets Priority Plan and the Sidewalk Construction Recommendation Committee's Report are attached as well. Both of these aforementioned plans/reports identify Marlborough Road as a priority for sidewalk construction.

Also, I just want to make sure the Board recognizes that the St. Mark's Street/Route 85 intersection project is the third, of four, locations in the Town's awarded Downtown and Various Streets Project contract. Each section was vetted separately or as part of the Main Street Reconstruction TIP project. The other locations in the current Downtown and Various Streets Project contract are:

- L1** Downtown Main Street, including water main replacement, drainage work, sidewalks and paving from the eastern end of the Main Street Reconstruction TIP Project, at Park Street, east past the train tracks to the intersection with Boston Road, then North down Newton Street to the Medical Building.
- L2** Sidewalk improvements on Cordaville Road heading south from the southern end of the Main Street Reconstruction TIP Project to the northern Cemetery entrance.
- L4** The project also includes intersection improvements to the Flagg Road/Deerfoot Road intersection, as recommended by the 2016 Flagg Road Safety Study.

I hope that this information helps with the Board's tree hearing appeals, gives the Board, and the public, context for the St. Mark's Street intersection part of the contract, as well as context for the overall Downtown and Various Streets Project contract.

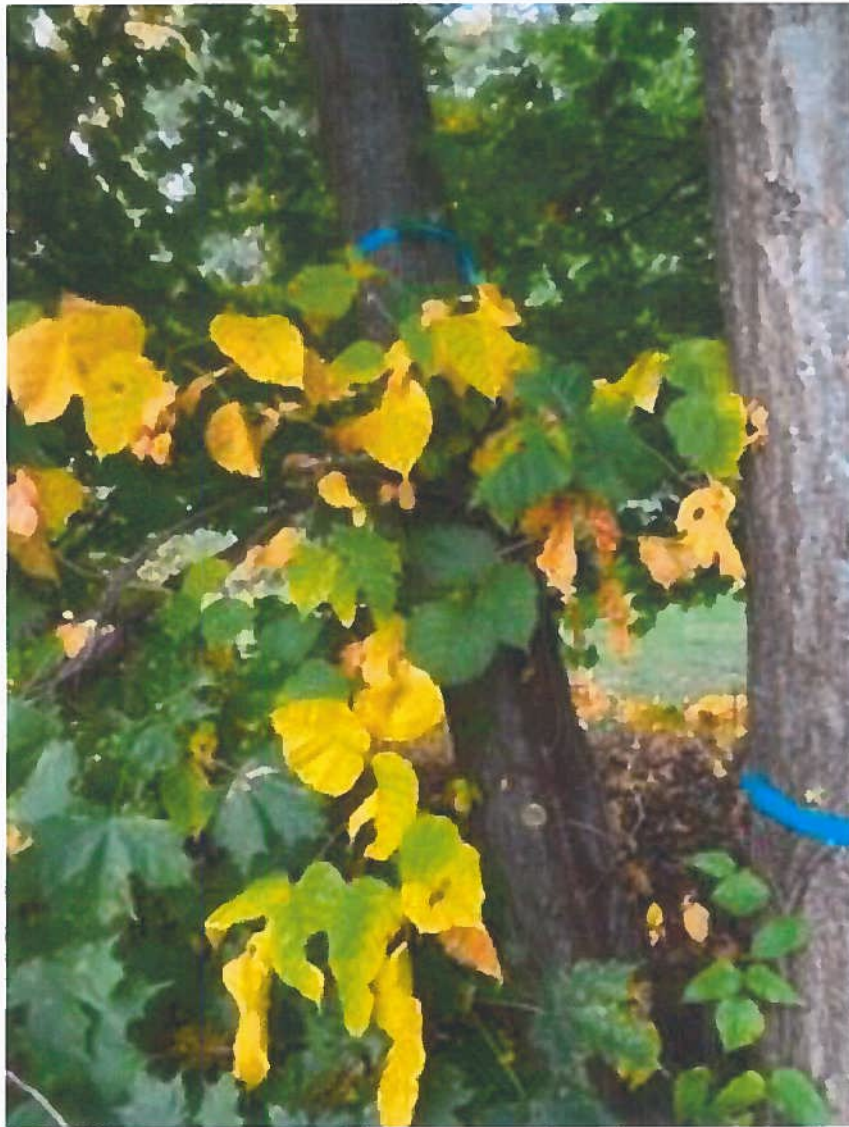

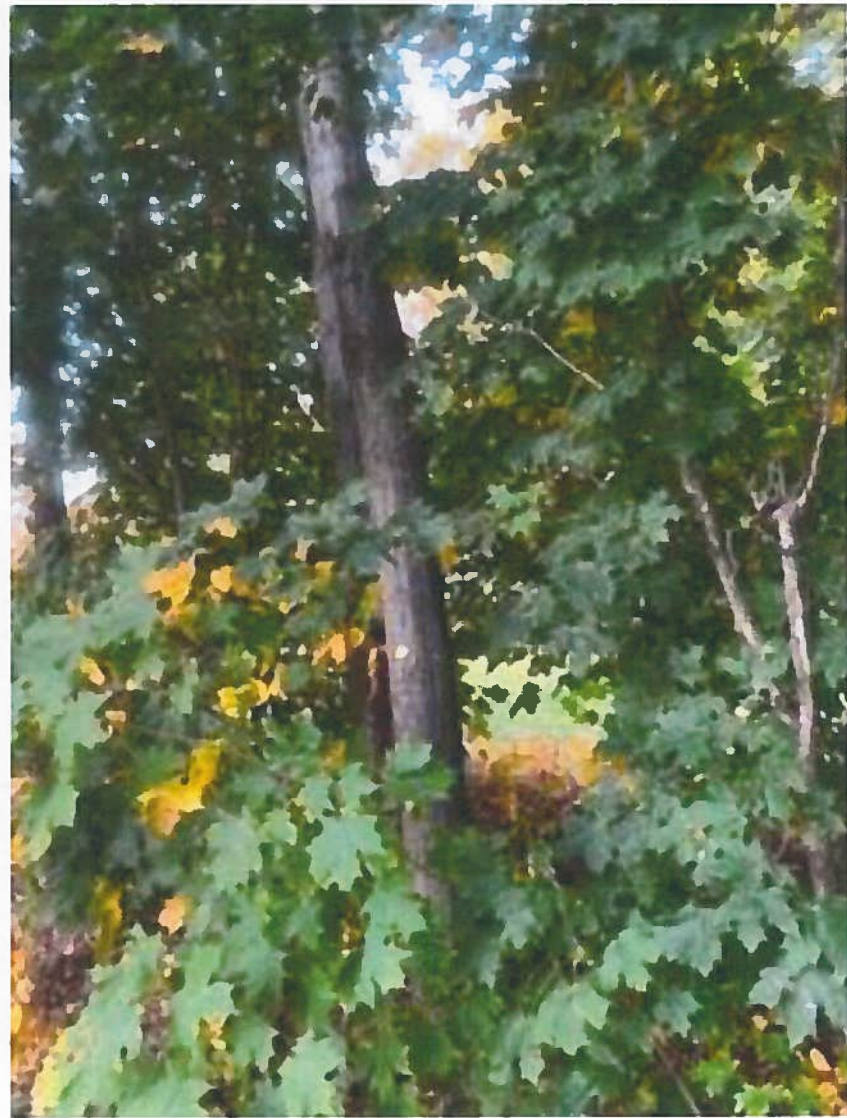
16" Ash – Tag 30



12" Oak – Tag 33



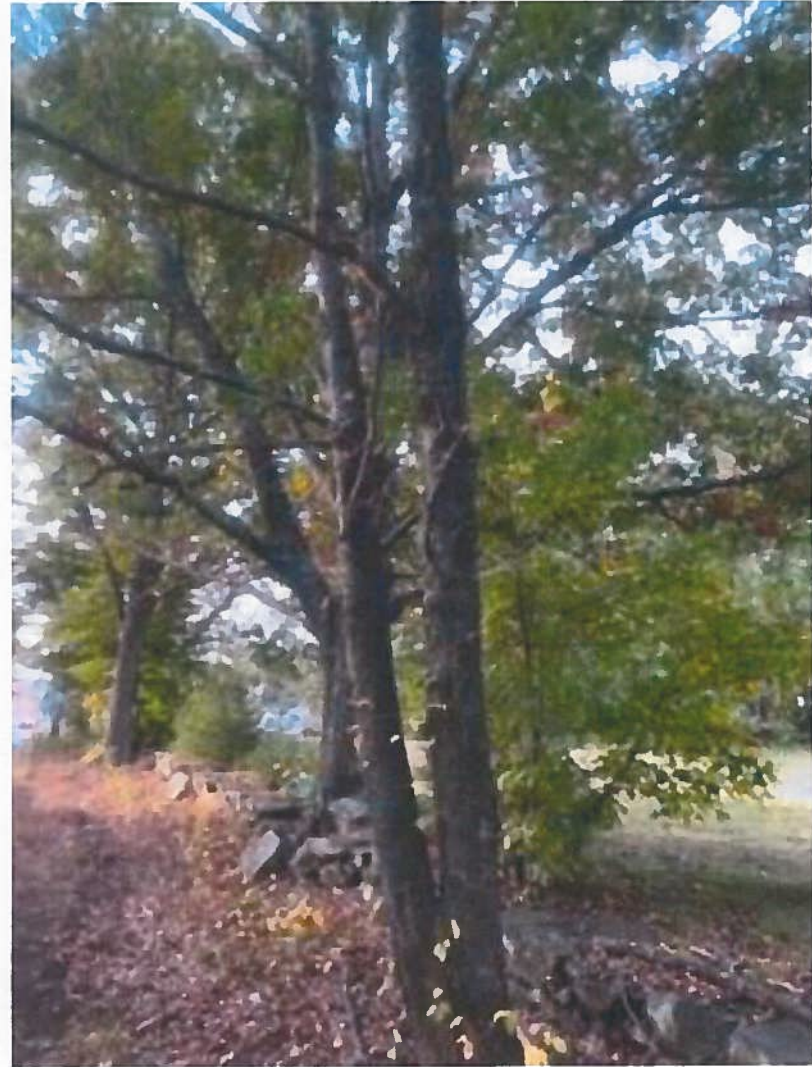
8" Oak – Tag 37



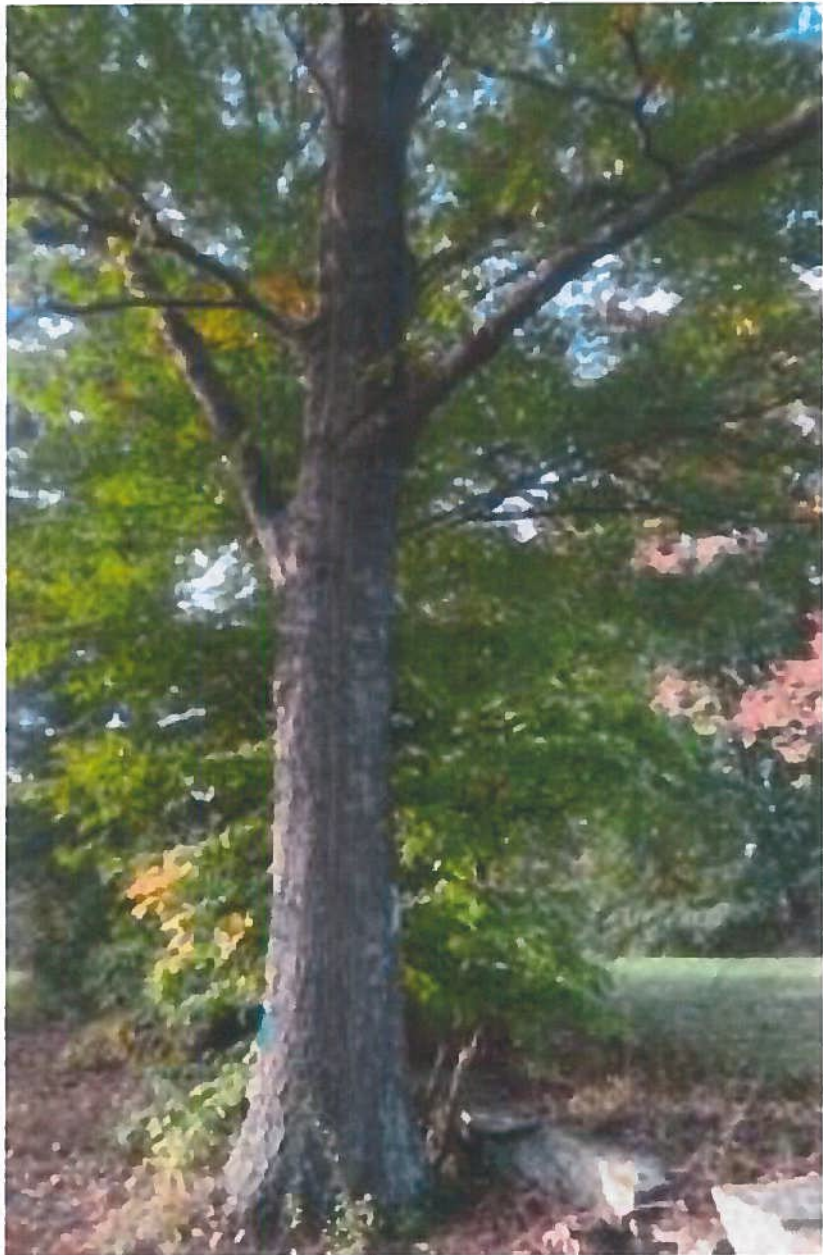

I object to the removal of the following shade trees:

16" ash, Tag 30
12" oak, Tag 33
8" oak, Tag 37
8" oak, Tag 36
12" maple, Tag 38
28" ash (double), Tag 39
36" oak, Tag 45
5" oak, Tag 46
10: oak, Tag 34

My objection to the removals is hereby made in writing, in accordance with MGL Part 1, title xiv, Ch 87, sec. 4. This requires a hearing by BOS to review the proposed removals.

I am requesting this as a private citizen not as a Library trustee.

I am also requesting that the DPW and Karen would please provide a copy of the current plan for the proposed park, road paving, and parking lot changes to the the Library Board of Trustees. The next meeting of the Library Board is Nov. 16 at 11 am.

There is a concern that tree removal and increased paving will impact ground water absorption and lead to increased water flow to the library, which has been subject to frequent flooding. In addition, there is a concern that Library parking may be impacted.
