## YES! (Youth Expressions of Southborough) Art Contest Requirements & Guidelines

- **Securely tape this form to the back of your art.**
- **Your artist signature on your art:** Be sure it is at least 1-inch from the edge of your paper.
- Applicants must be residents of Southborough, Massachusetts.
- Applicants must be in grades 1-8.
- Art submissions must be solely created by the young person submitting art.
- Standard size white drawing paper such as 9x11 or 12x18 are recommended.
- Art must be 2-D. It can be colored using any medium. 3-D art is not permitted.
- Artists should sign their art. Artists may choose whether they sign their work with their full name or first name on the front of their art.
- Winning entries will be reproduced onto canvas and displayed at local offices, businesses, and public spaces.
- Original art submissions will be returned to the child's school by the end of the 2022-2023 school year.
- Winning participants' names will be published in local news sources such as newspapers and online news sources such as mysouthborough.com.
