Dear Applicant,

Enclosed please find the 2023 application for the **Town of Southborough Scholarship**, the **Carroll Harris Memorial Scholarship** and the **Linda Hubley Memorial Scholarship**. Southborough residents who are high school seniors or in a post-secondary undergraduate program may apply for one or more of these awards.

The Southborough Town Scholarship takes into consideration volunteer and work experiences that benefit the Southborough Community, academics, financial need, extracurricular activities, as well as written expression.

The Carroll Harris Memorial Scholarship uses the same criteria as the Southborough Town Scholarship, and the applicant must have participated in gymnastics, or plan to major in physical education, education or recreation, or have demonstrated active participation in a town recreation program.

The Linda Hubley Memorial Scholarship uses the same criteria as the Southborough Town Scholarship and the applicant should demonstrate a commitment to their community through volunteerism, environmental protection and/or ongoing education in these areas.

It is important for candidates to correctly identify whether they are applying for one or all of these scholarships by checking the appropriate box on page 2 of the application.

When applying for any of the scholarships, please pay attention to the specifics of the question, which ask candidates if they have applied for financial aid and, if so, what their Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is. If you have applied for aid, please attach a copy of the front page of your Student Aid Report. We only require the front page in order to see the EFC; we do not want the financial details reported on the back. Please be assured that this information will be kept in the strictest confidence. Although financial need is considered, it is not the most important factor in awarding a scholarship.

Please note that applications, along with all transcripts and appraisals, must be returned to the Southborough Town House by **Monday, May 8th, 2023 by 4:00pm**. ***Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.*** It is the student's responsibility to include each of the requested items in their application package. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and scholarship recipients will be notified by phone and email. Awards will be presented during a Southborough Select Board Meeting.

To All Applicants:

In 1987 the Town of Southborough established the Scholarship Fund.

In 1999, the Southborough Youth Gymnastics Association (SYGA) established the Carroll Harris Memorial Scholarship. It is given to a student who participates in gymnastics, or in education, physical education or recreation, or who has demonstrated active participation in a town recreation program.

In 2022 the Linda Hubley Memorial Scholarship was established. It is given to a student who demonstrates a commitment to their community through volunteerism, environmental protection and/or ongoing education in these areas.

The answers to the Extra-Curricular Section should reflect one of these focus areas.

All Southborough residents planning post-secondary undergraduate study, as well as those presently in a post-secondary undergraduate program, are eligible to apply for these scholarships.

In order to be considered for any of these scholarships, applications must arrive **at the Town House by Monday, May 8th, 2023 by 4:00pm.**

The following items must be included for high school applicants:

- Completed application
- Completed applicant appraisal
- Official high school transcript (must be provided by applicant)
- If applying for financial aid, you must attach the front page of the Student Aid Report

The following items must be included for post-secondary applicants:

- Completed application
- Completed applicant appraisal (do not use a high school appraisal)
- Official high school transcript **and** post-secondary transcript (mandatory if you are a freshman, this may be just one semester)
