## SOUTHBOROUGH TOWN PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION

Are you a Senior or Disabled and struggling to pay your Town property taxes?

The Taxation Aid Committee may be able to help!

The Senior and Disabled Taxation Aid Fund exists to alleviate the property tax burden for Southborough's senior and/or disabled citizens who demonstrate need.

The Committee is comprised of the Town's Finance Director/Treasurer-Collector, the Chair of the Board of Assessors and three resident volunteers.

Requirements: You must own and currently occupy your residence in Southborough for 5 or more consecutive years. You or your spouse must be a minimum of 65 years of age. Income cannot exceed \$30,000 per individual or \$60,000 for your total household per year. Residents with a "state recognized disability" are also eligible.
