

## **SOUTHBOROUGH TOWN PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION**

**Are you a Senior or Disabled and struggling to pay your Town property taxes?**

**The Taxation Aid Committee may be able to help!**

**The Senior and Disabled Taxation Aid Fund exists to alleviate the property tax burden for Southborough's senior and/or disabled citizens who demonstrate need.**

**The Committee is comprised of the Town's Finance Director/Treasurer-Collector, the Chair of the Board of Assessors and three resident volunteers.**

**Requirements: You must own and currently occupy your residence in Southborough for 5 or more consecutive years. You or your spouse must be a minimum of 65 years of age. Income cannot exceed \$30,000 per individual or \$60,000 for your total household per year. Residents with a "state recognized disability" are also eligible.**

**Applications are accepted in the month of February.**

**Granted awards will be credited directly to the applicant's real estate tax account for the November tax payment. The applicant must be the owner of the property at distribution.**
