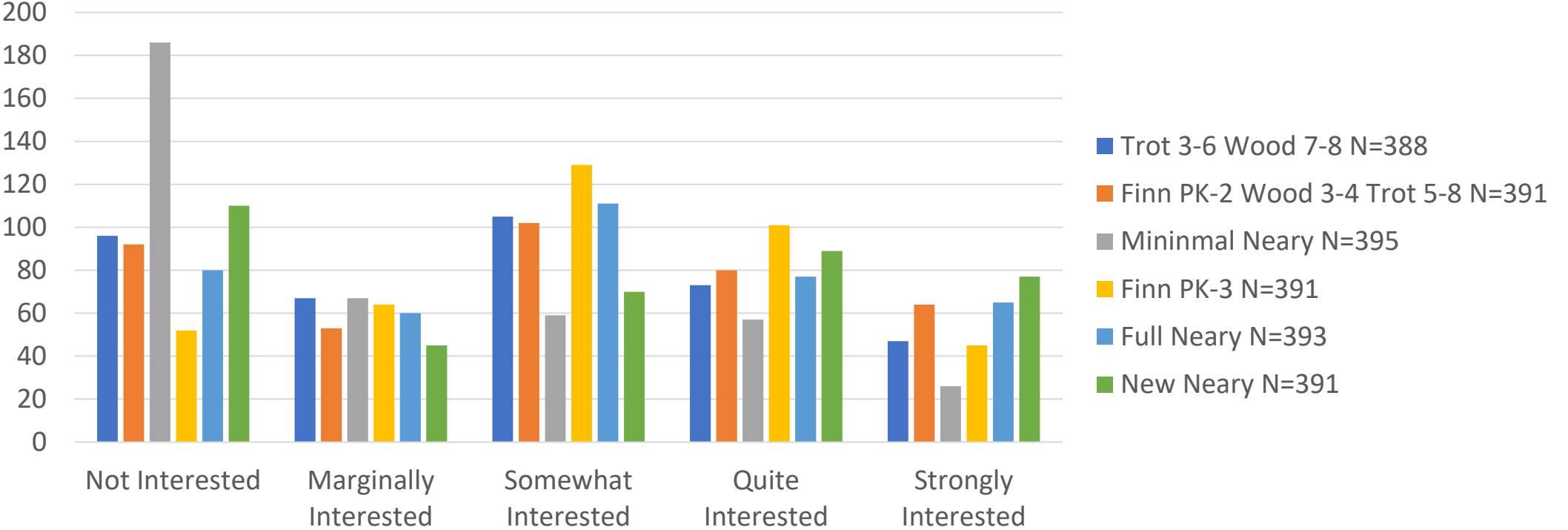


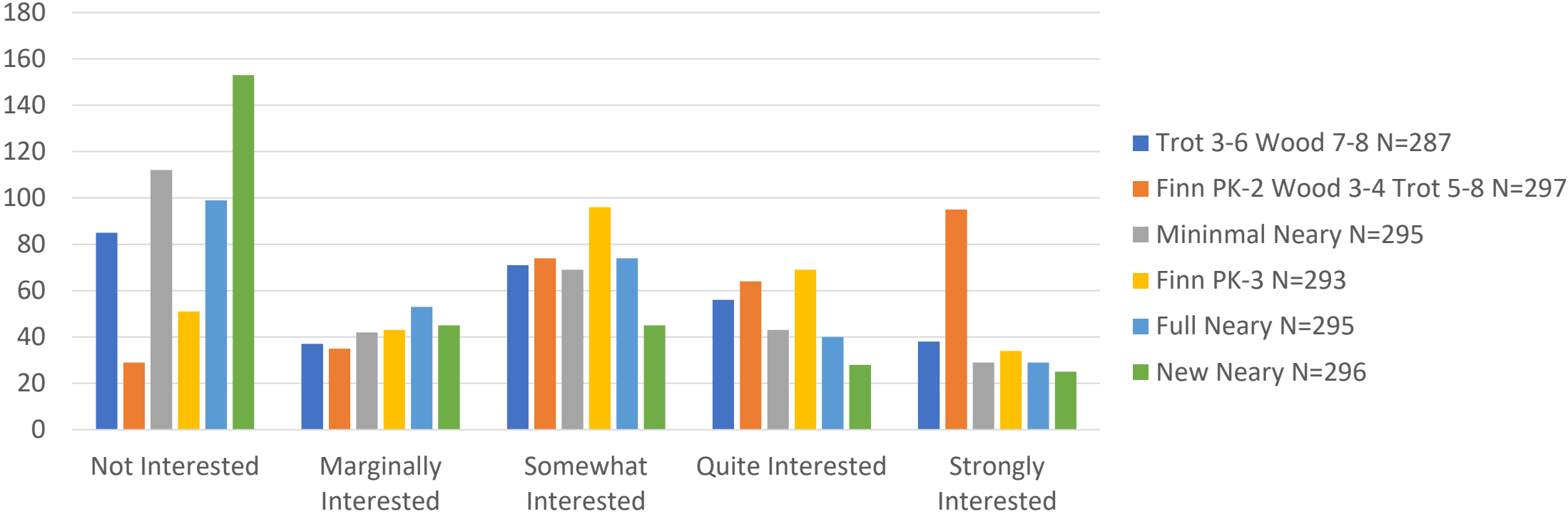

Project Preferences, Adults with Pre K-8 Children (~31% of Adult Population)



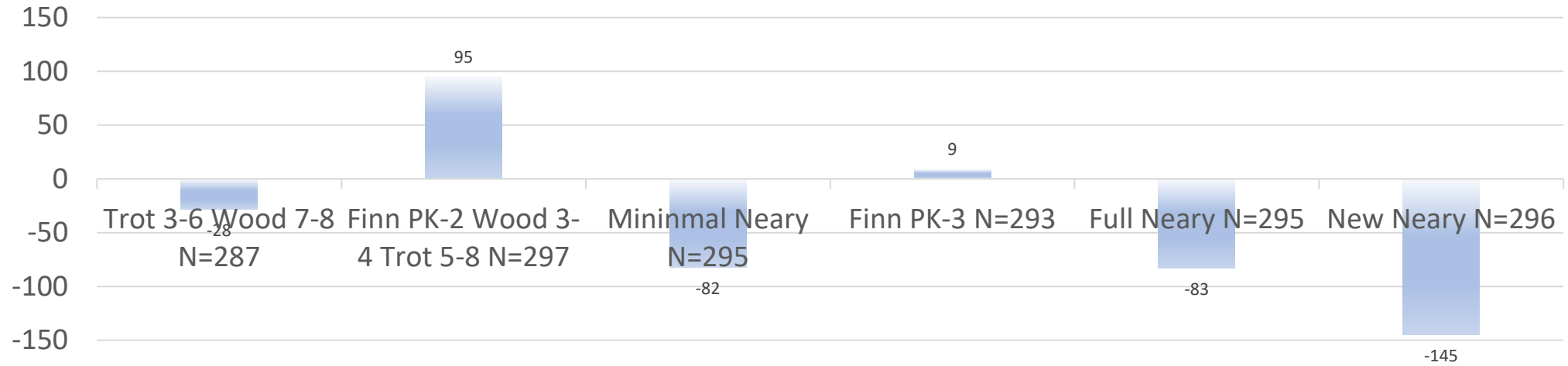

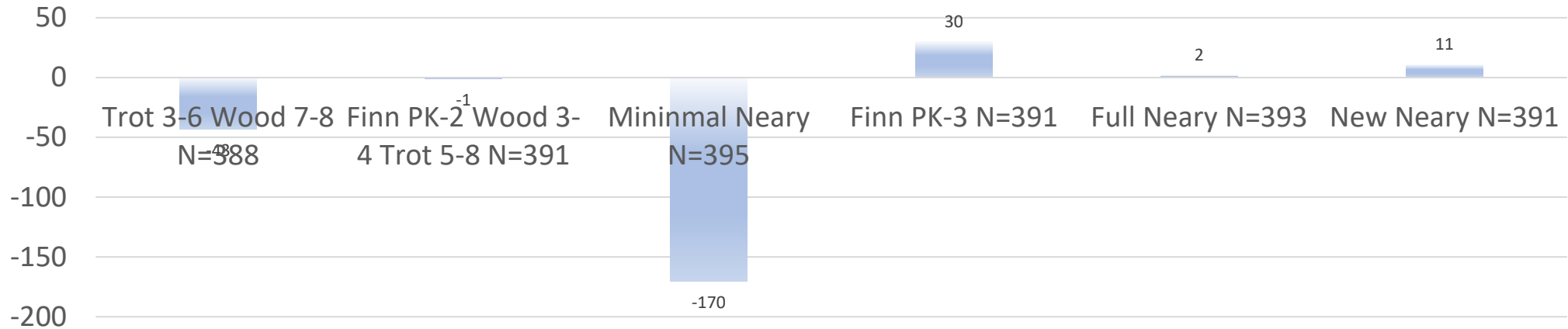

Adults without Pre K-8 Children (~69% of adults) Net Project Support ((Strong+Quite)-(Marginally+Not))



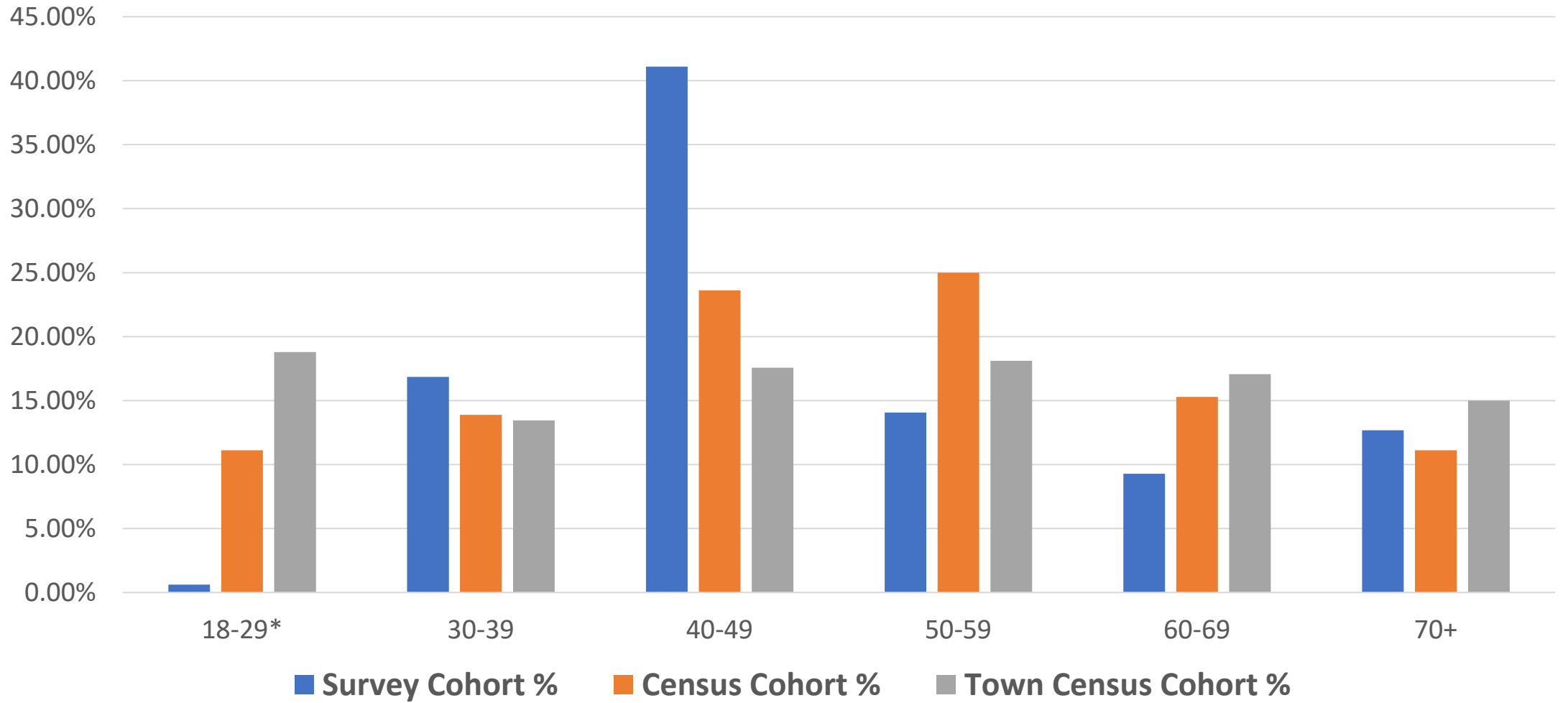
Adults with Pre K-8 Children (~31% of adults) Net Project Support ((Strong+Quite)-(Marginally+Not))



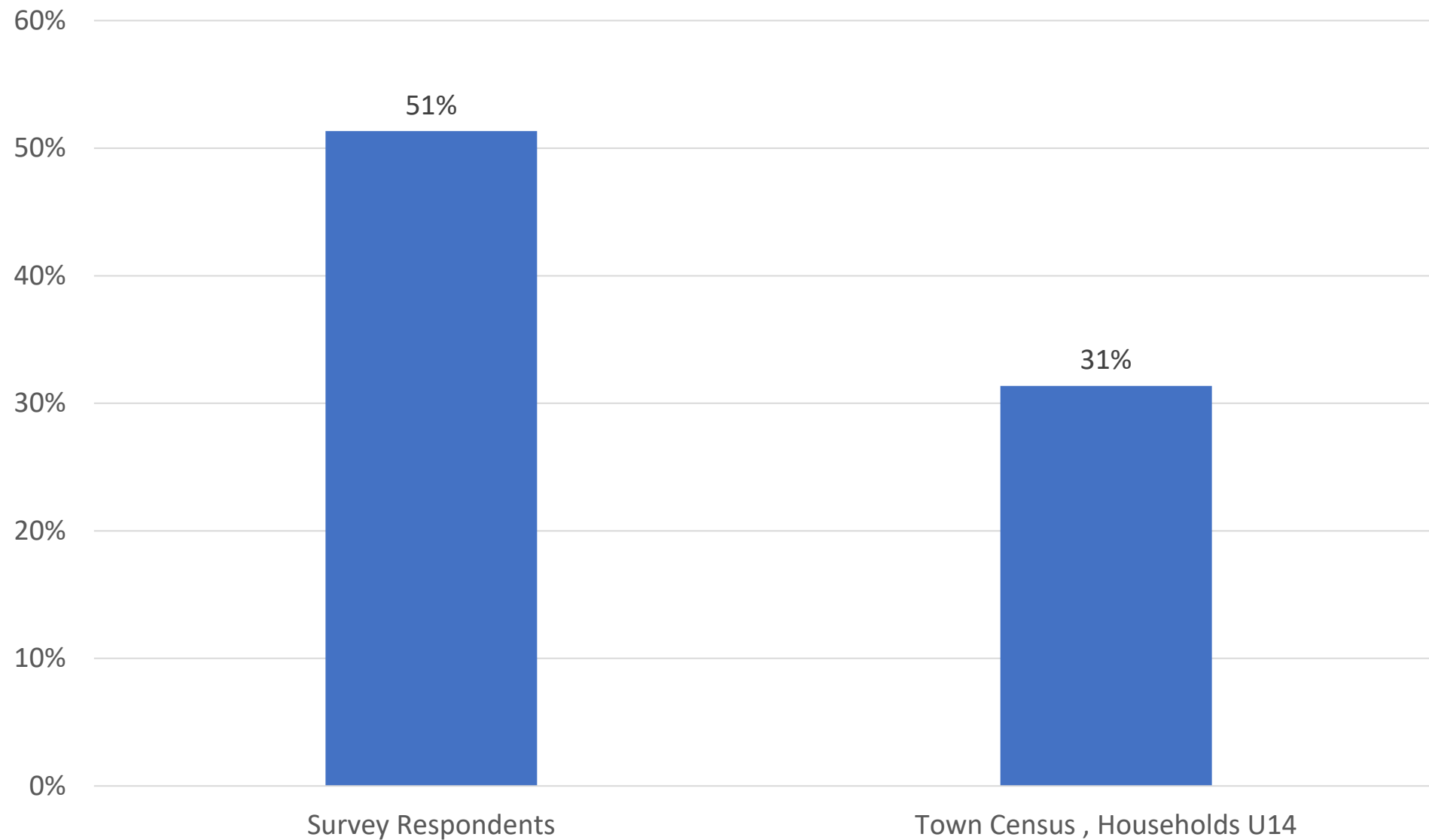

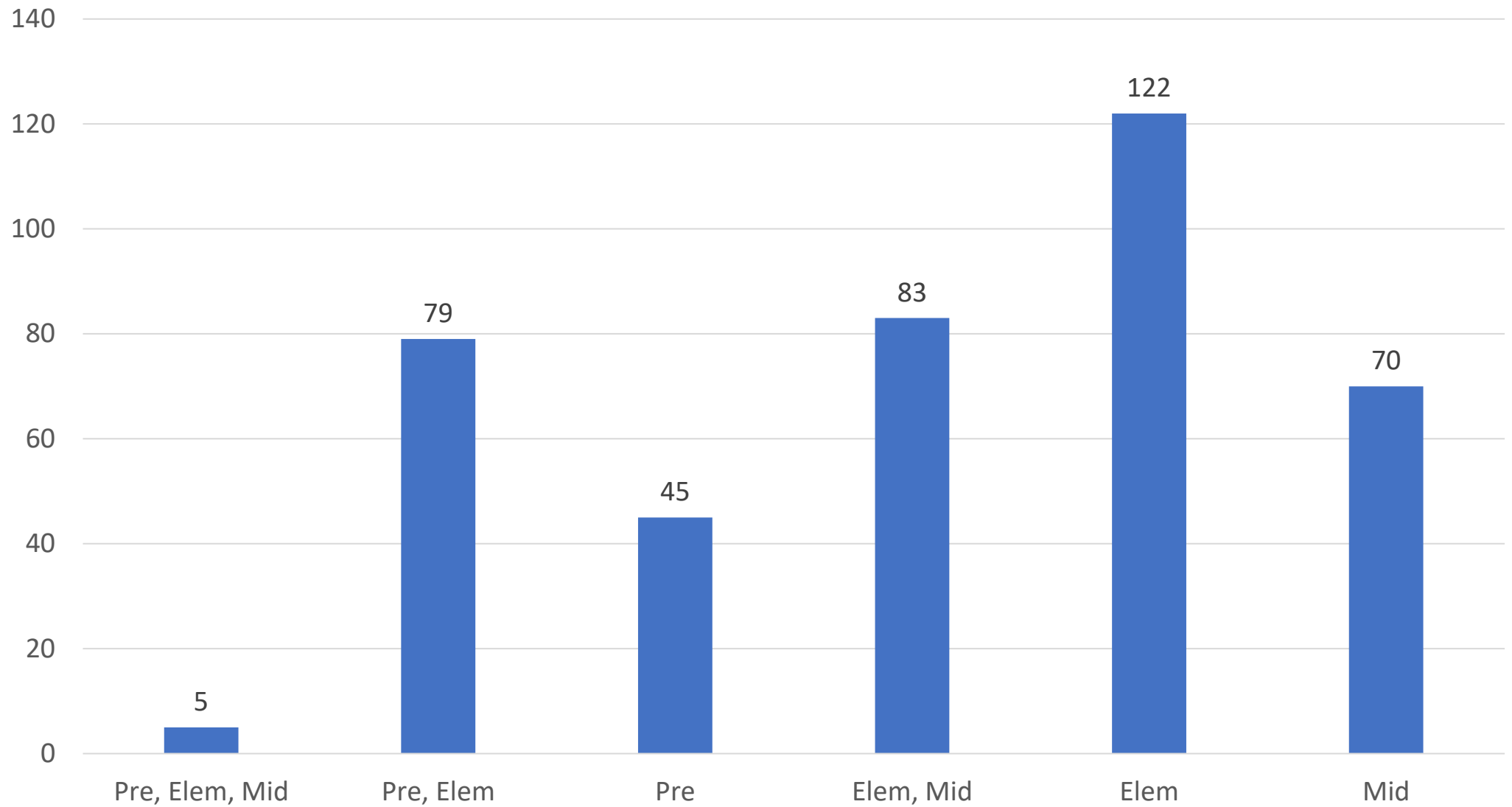


Survey Respondents Overall Percentage With Children Pre K - 8 vs % of
Households With Children Under 14 N=404

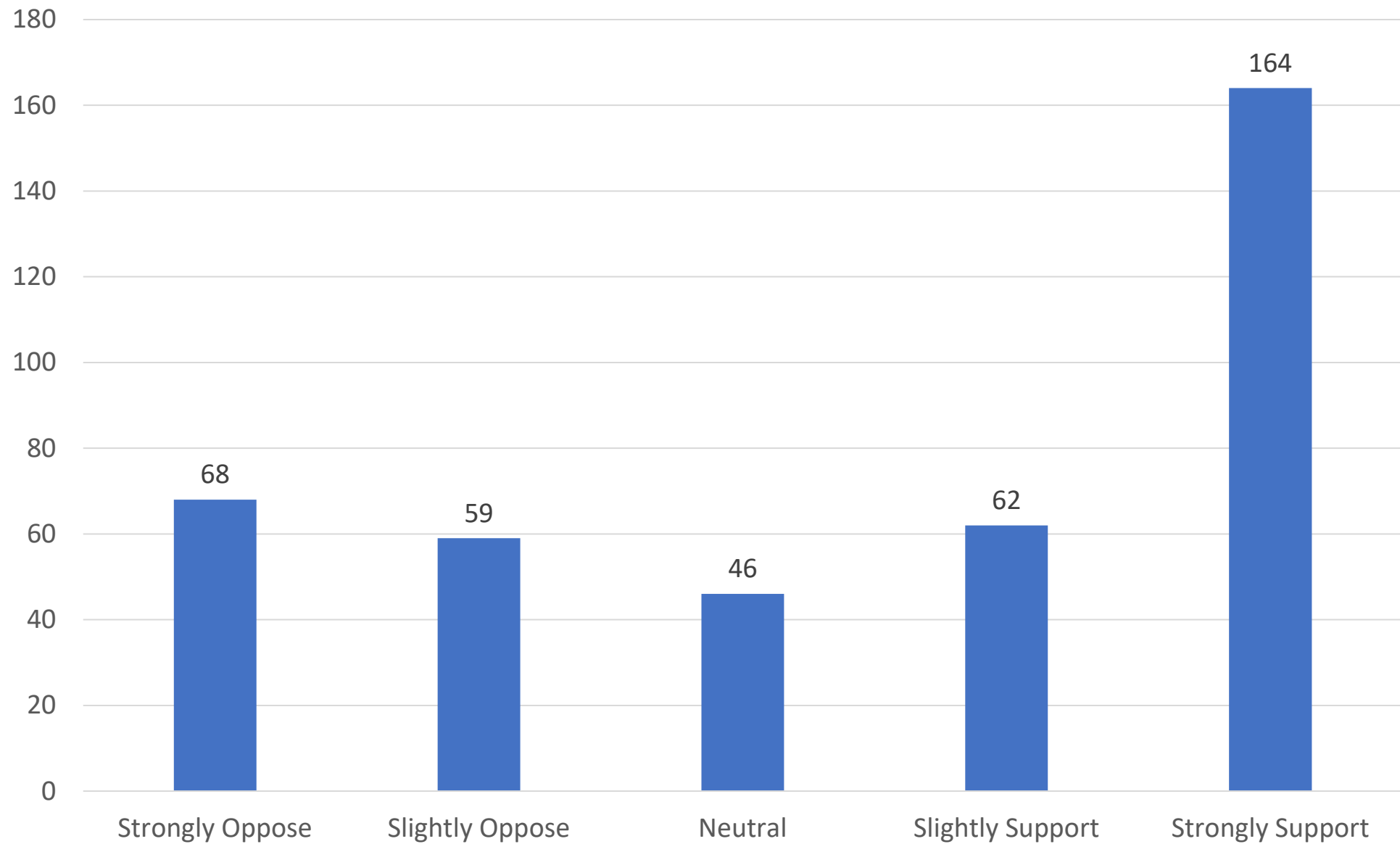

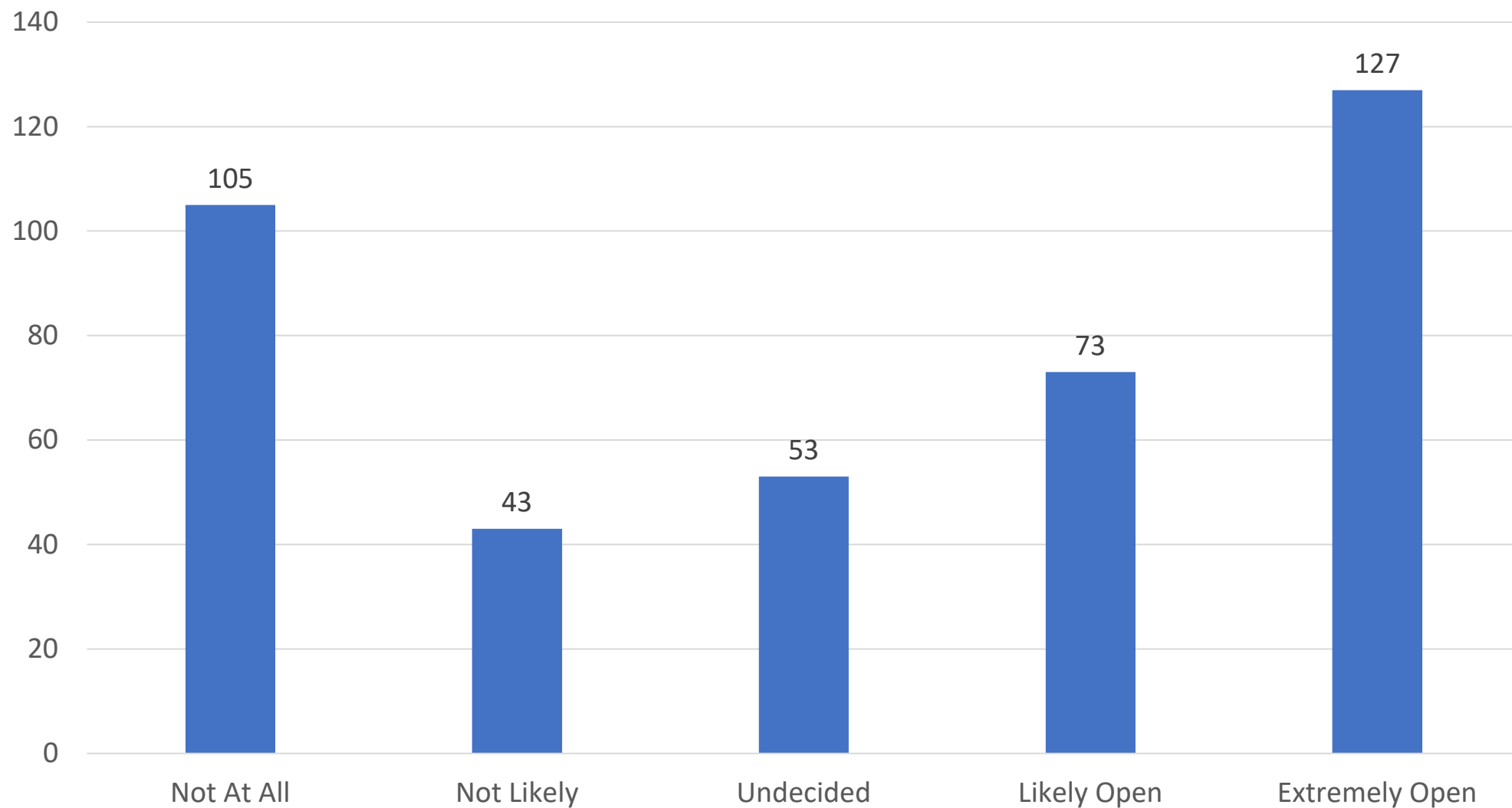

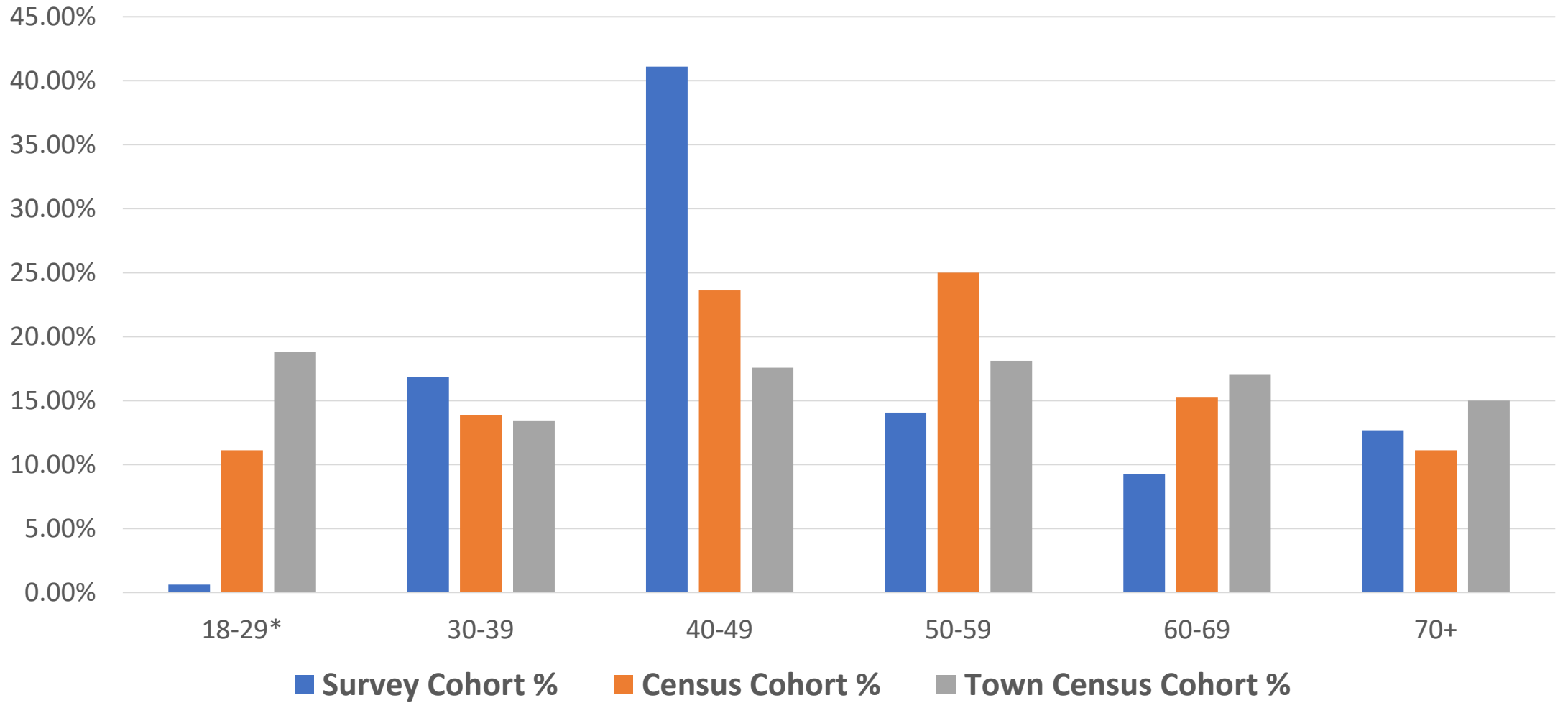
Survey Respondents with Children Pre k - 8, "Open to reconsider original proposal?" N=401



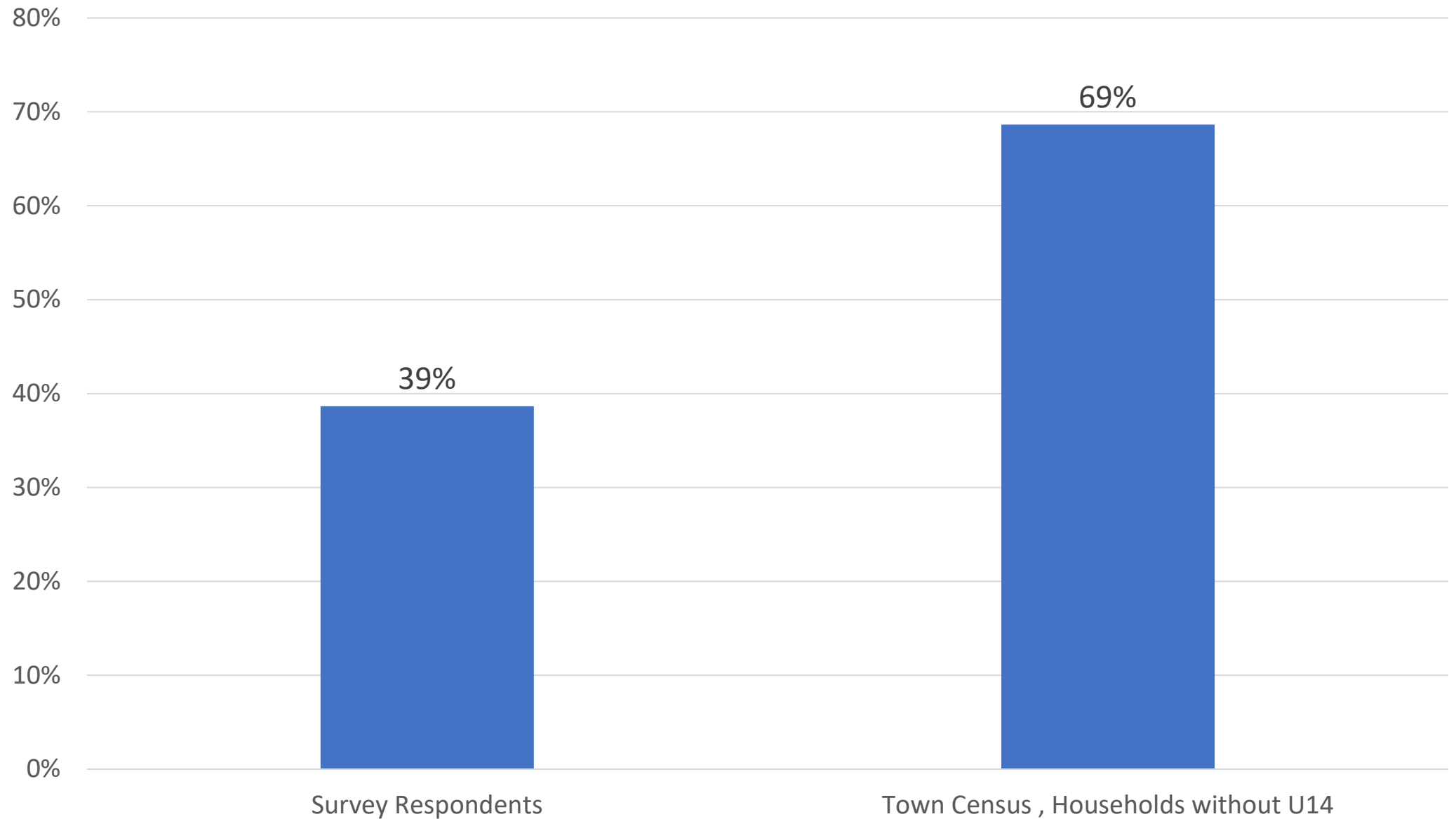

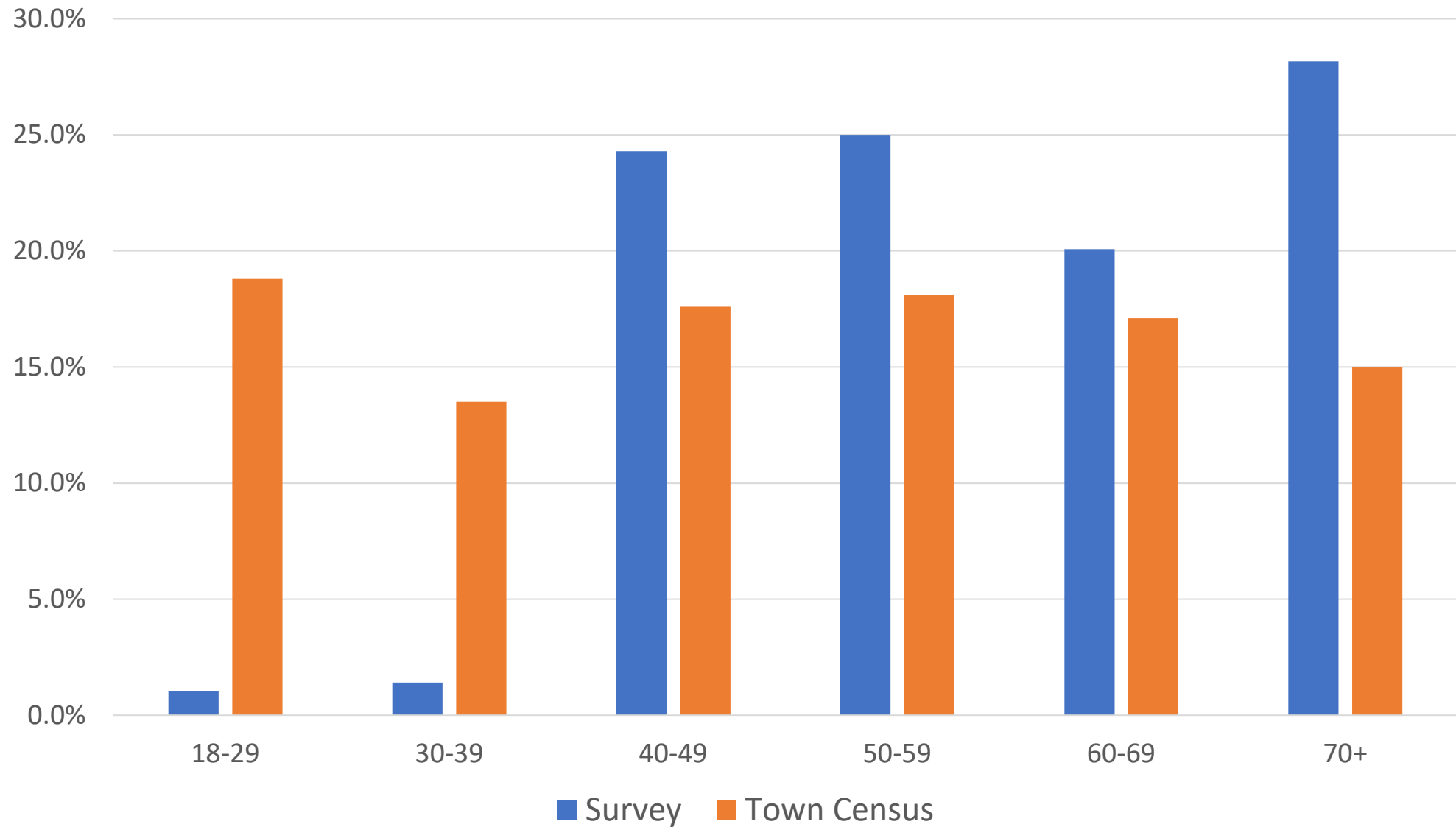

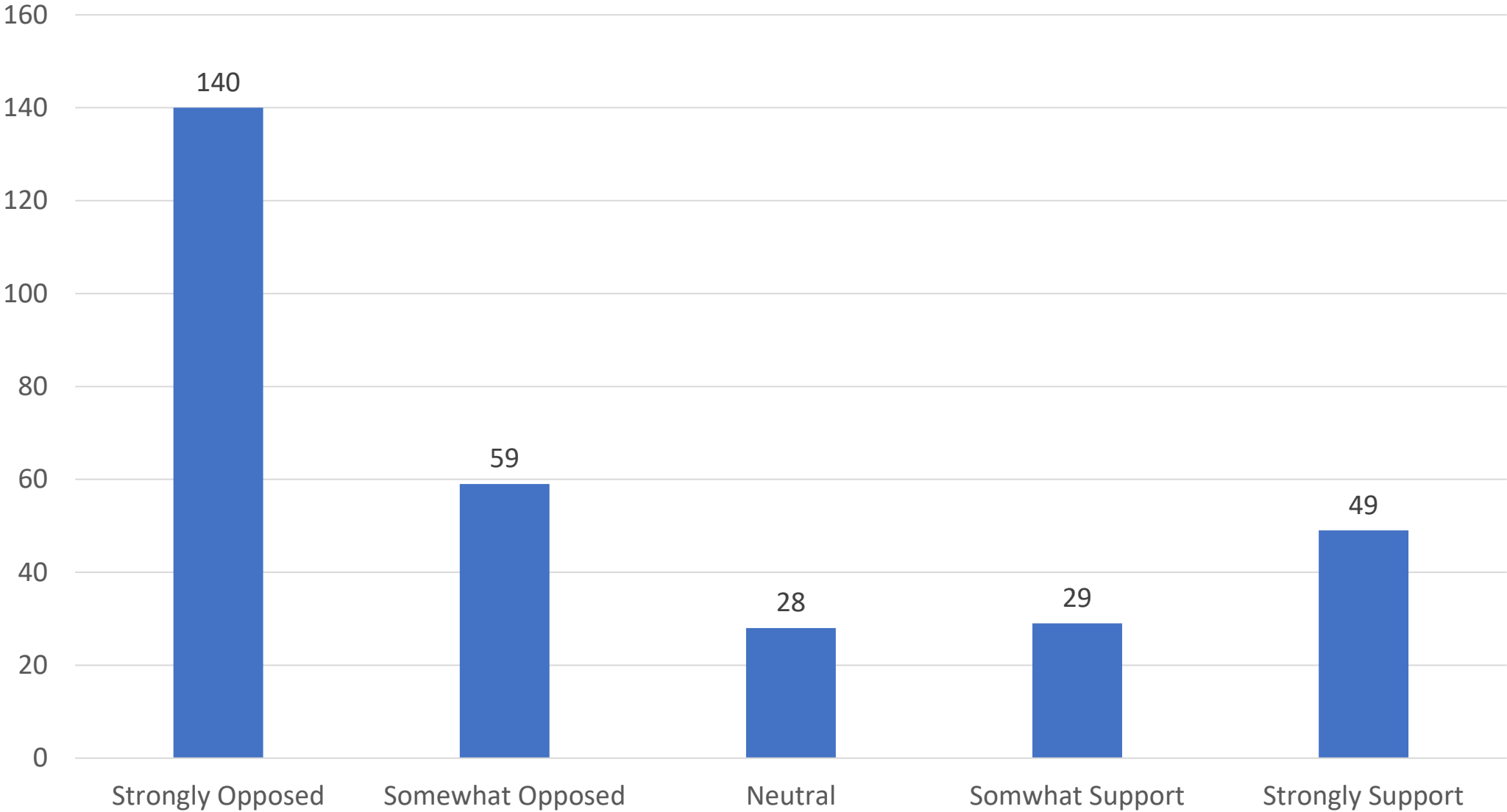
Survey Respondent % of total Responses, No Children in Pre K - 8 vs % of Households with No Children Under 14 N=305



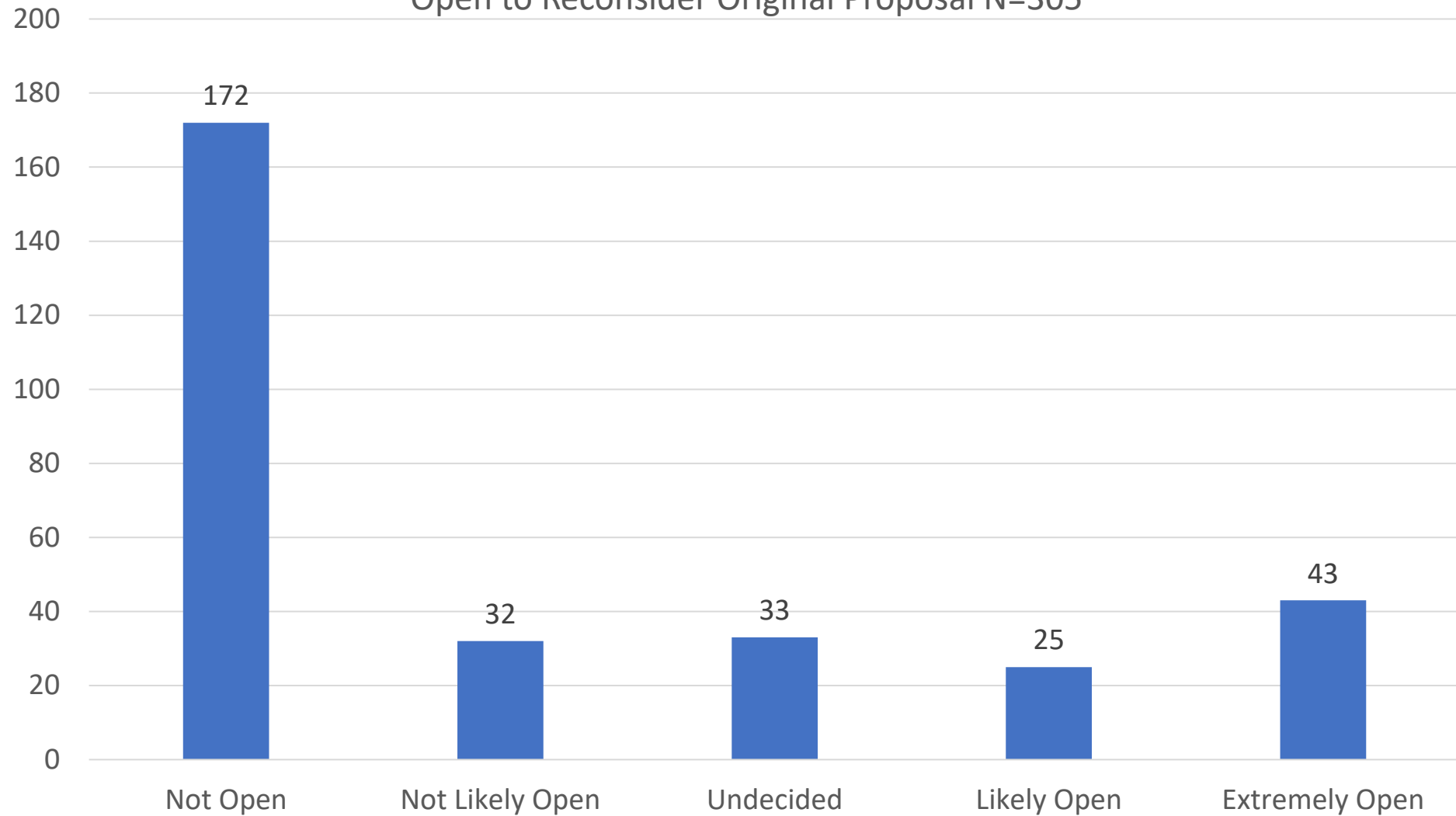
Survey Respondents Without Pre K-8 Children Age Cohort % vs Town Census %

Initial "New Neary" Position N=305



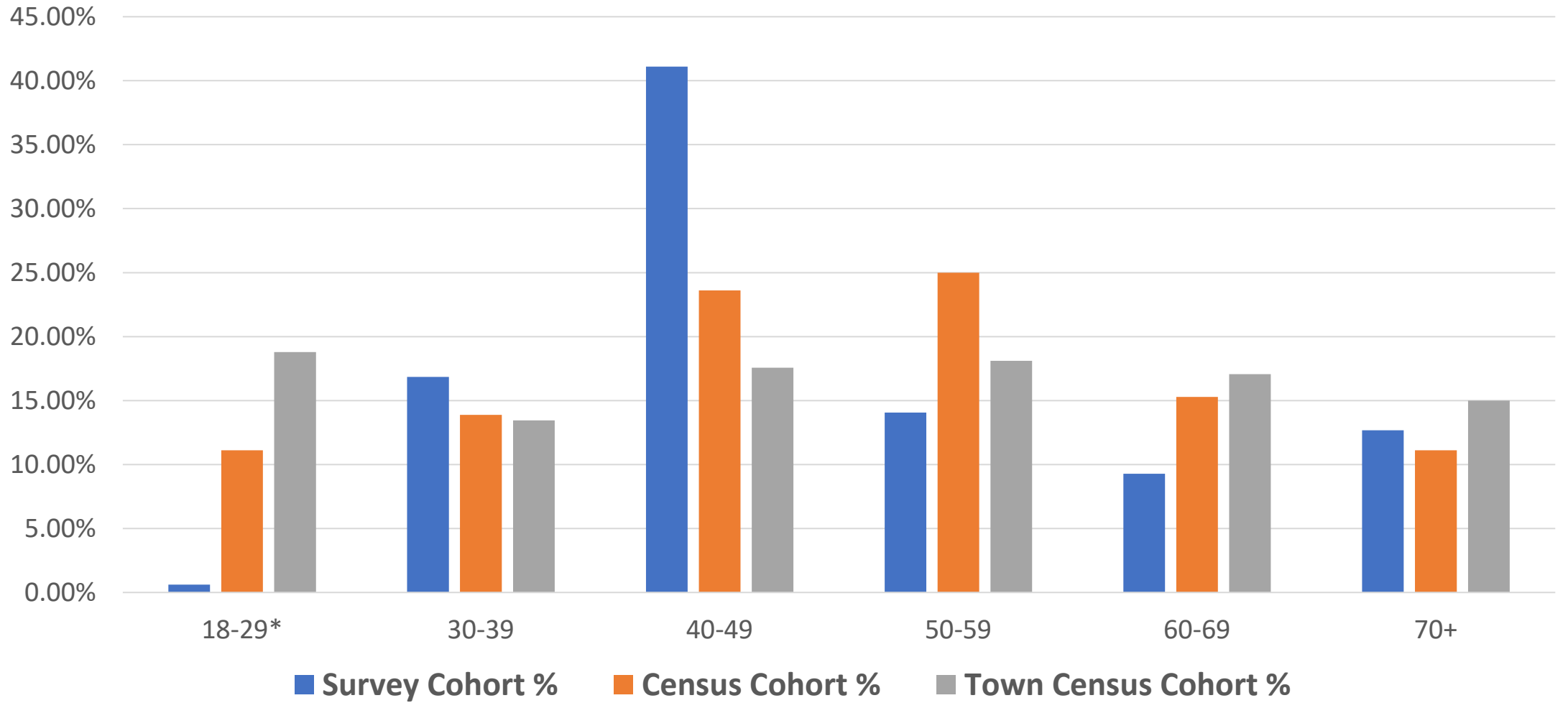

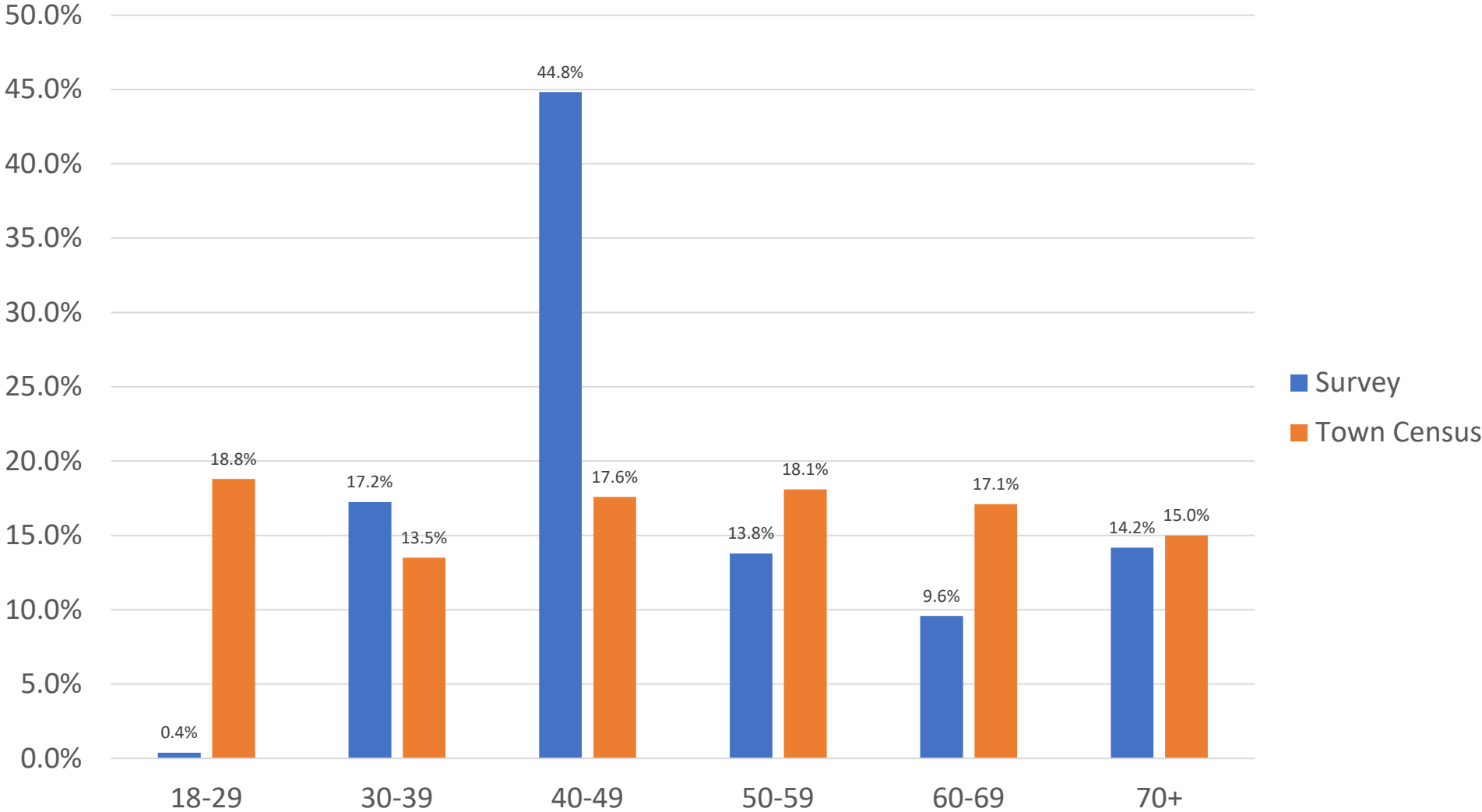

Adult Age Cohorts Percentiles, Survey Respondents vs Census Projection vs Town Census

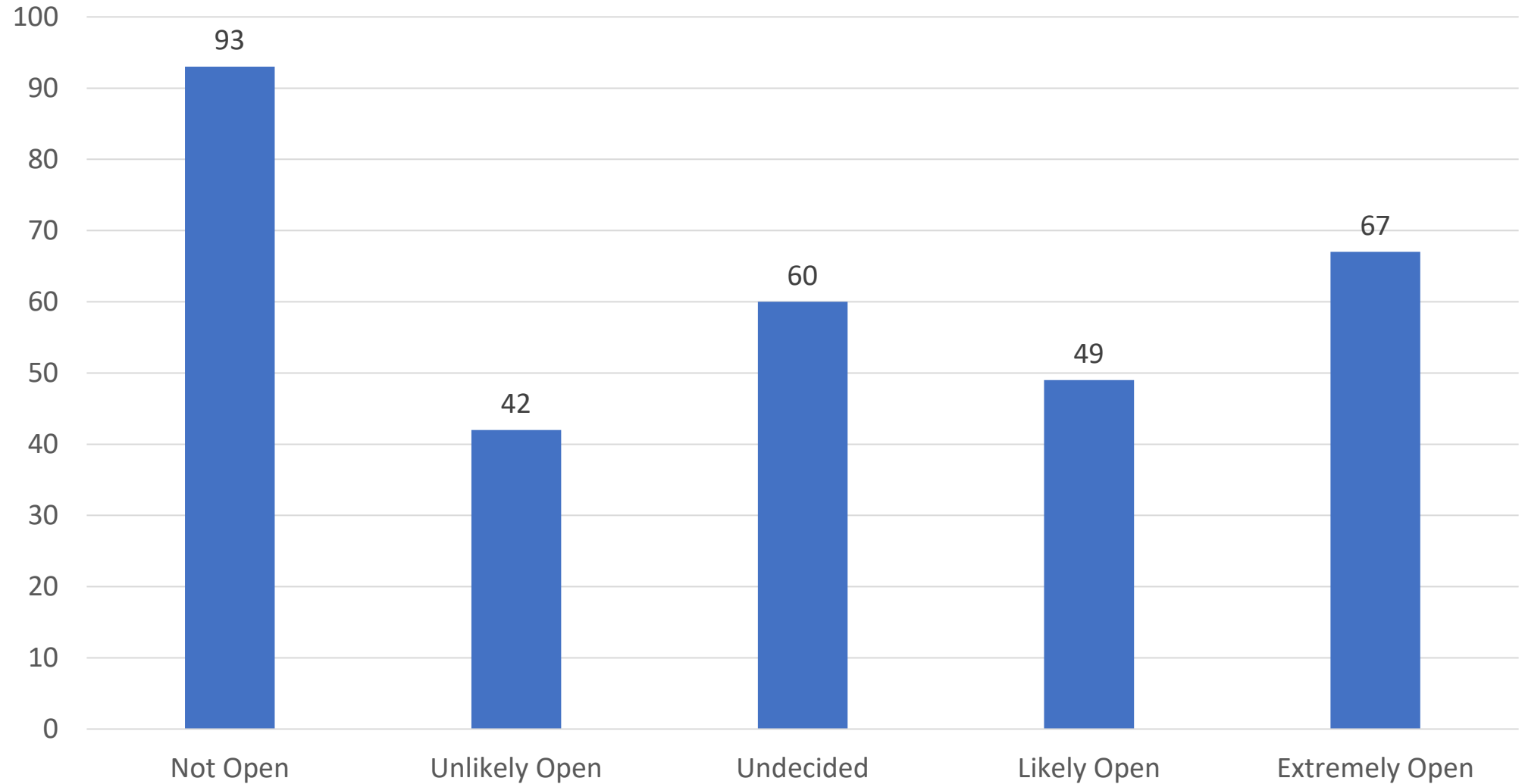

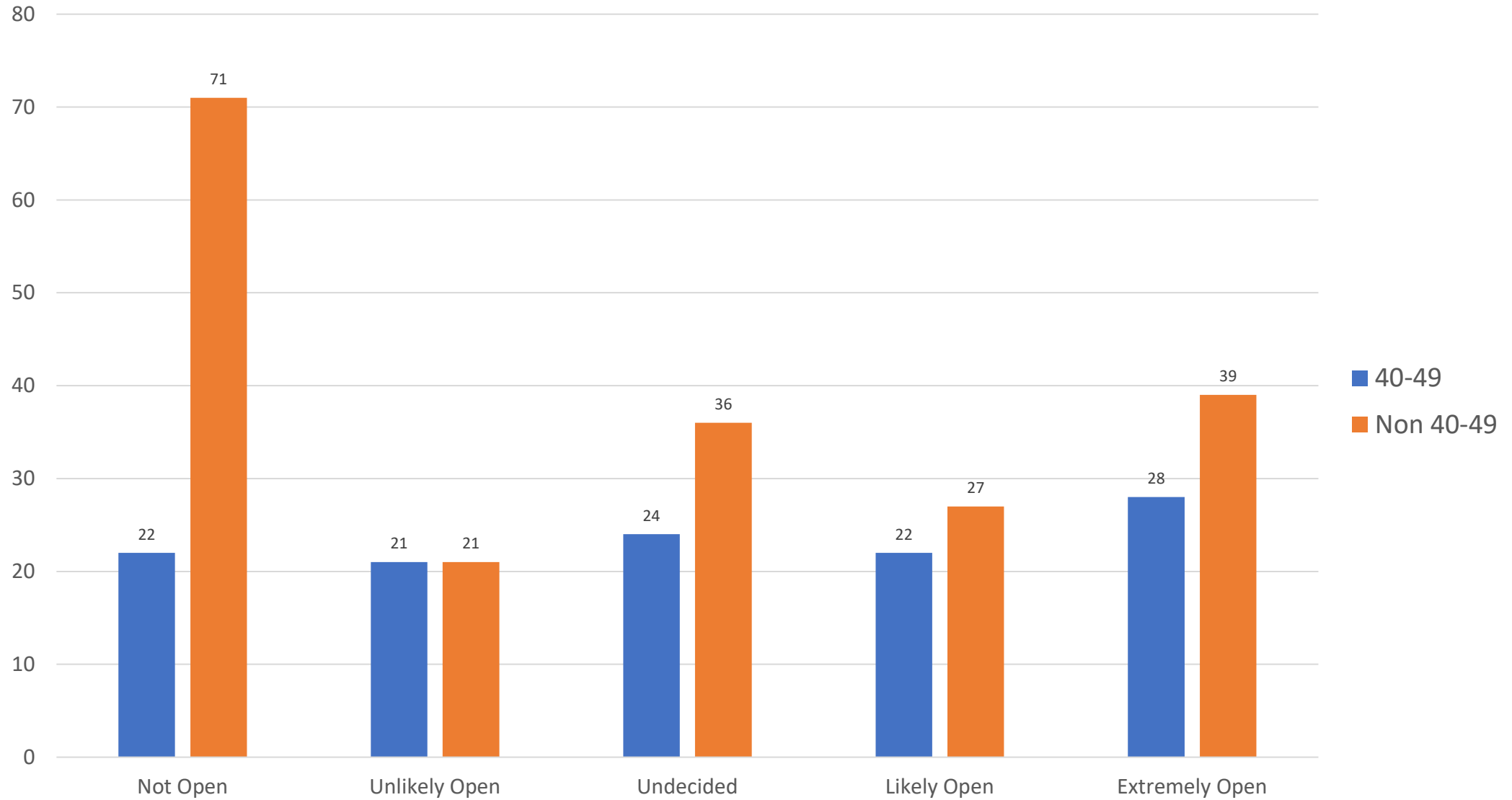
Non Town Meeting Attendee Survey Respondents- Age Cohort % (N=261) vs

Neary Proposal" N=311

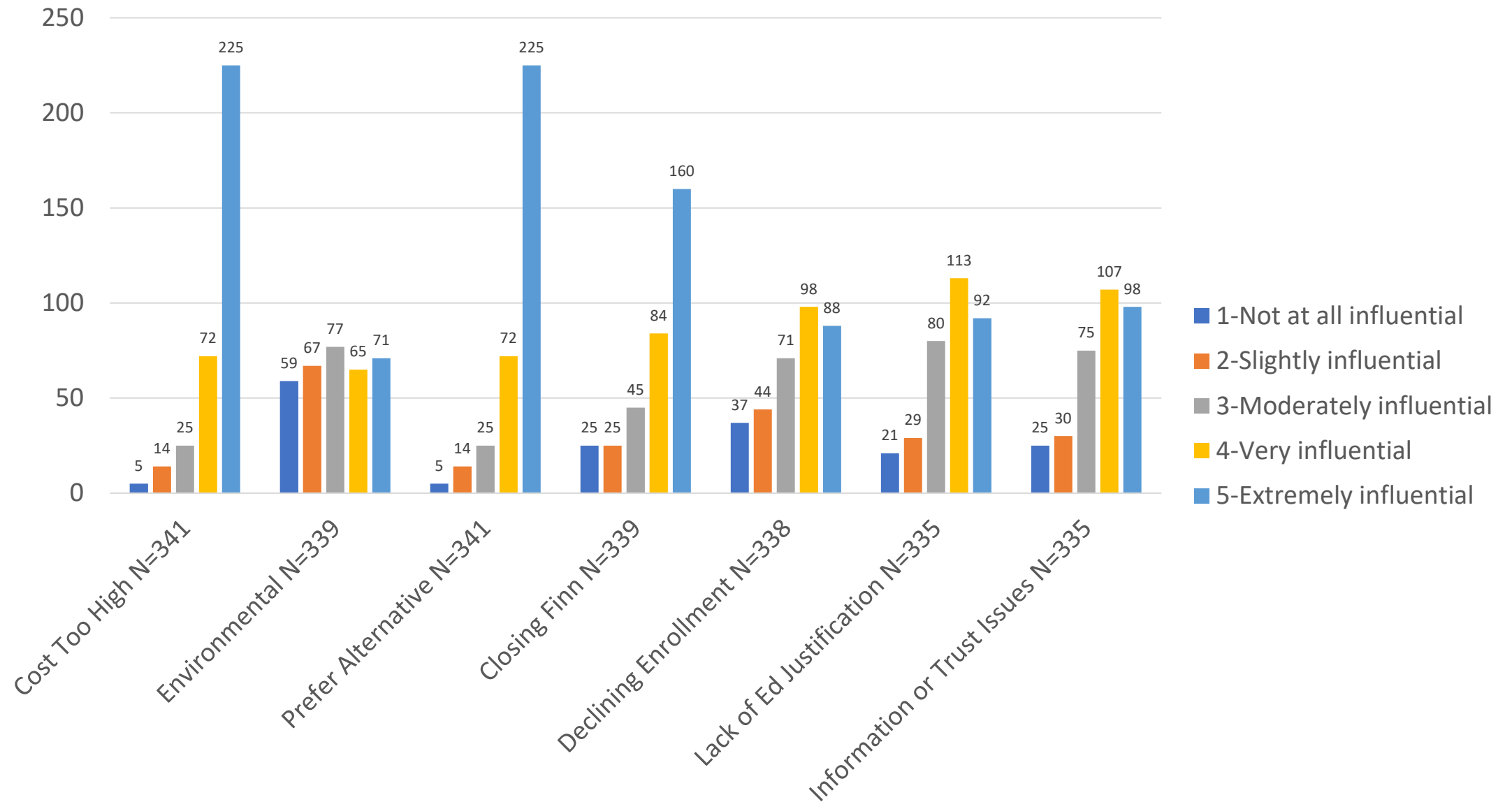


Non Town Meeting Attendees Survey Respondents Aged 40-49 vs Other Age Cohorts "Open to Reconsider Original Proposal" N=312

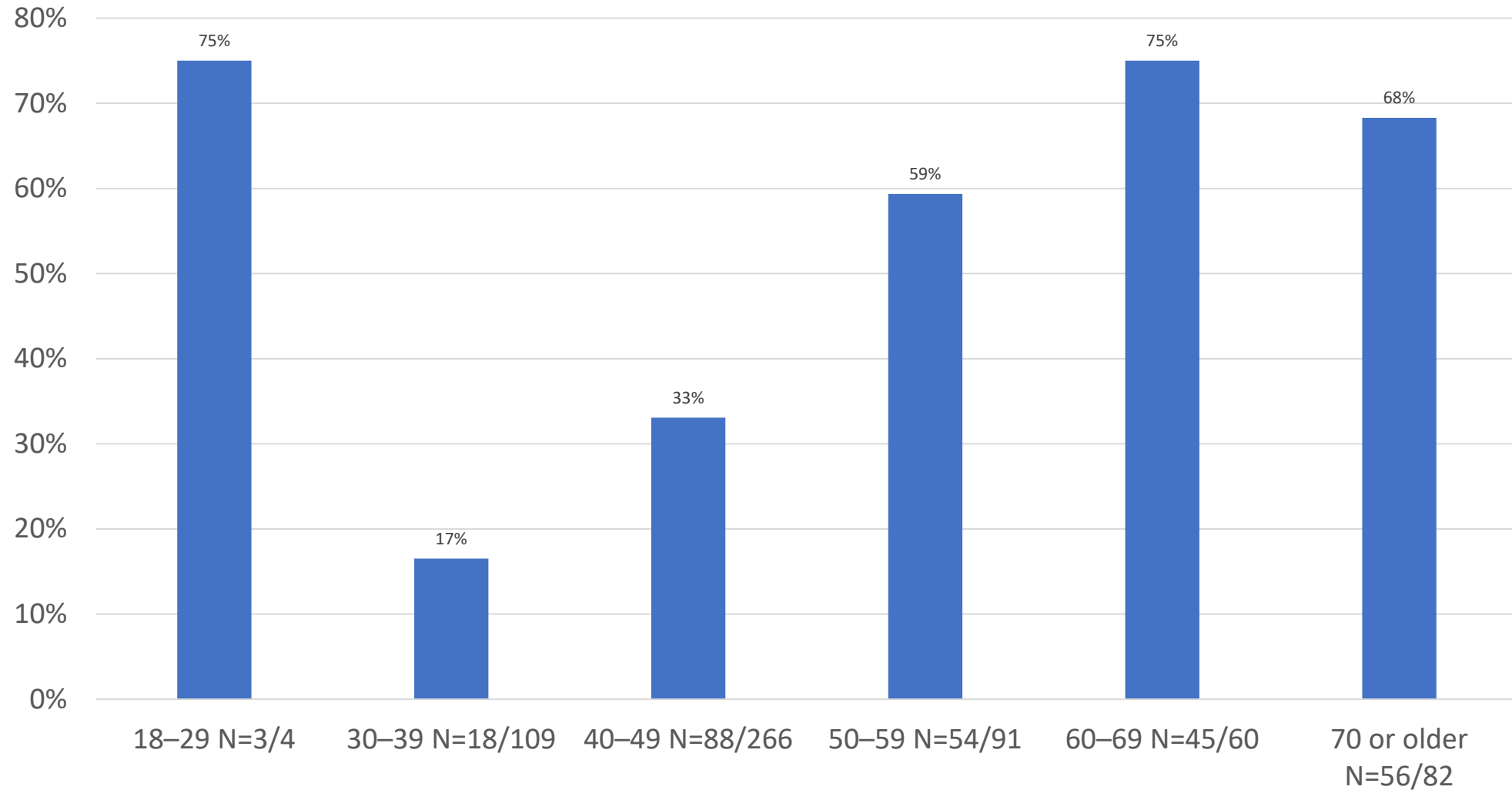


Profile of Survey Respondents Initially Strongly Opposed or Slightly Opposed to “New Neary”
